

The TVPBC Board Meeting was called to order at 1:35pm on June 18, 2025, by Gary Sawicki, President. In attendance were Gary Sawicki, Stacey O'Brien, Don MacLeod, Matt Frederick, Steve McCormick, and Anne Pickens to form a quorum.

Additional attendees: Tom LaFleur, Larry Moore and Thomas Cook

Minutes for April 15, 2025 Board meeting were approved.

Board Actions/Votes are highlighted in yellow.

Director reports were as follows:

PRESIDENT – Gary Sawicki

- Injury Prevention Program with TOA and the Rec. Dept.
 - This program has been slowed down due to staffing issues at TOA.
- Pickleball Tournament and Associated Events
 - Despite the weather challenges it was a huge success. Those that were able to play had fun and solid competition. The Veterans event on Friday evening was attended by experienced players as well as novices. The party was tons of fun on Monday evening. Smoky Mountain Service Dogs were well represented by staff and dogs at all events including 7 dogs at the veteran's event. Hooligan, the representative dog at the Fiesta Party collected close to \$1,000 at his pass the hat demonstration. Campbell Financial Group donated \$8,000 to the tournament and another \$1,000 to match Hooligan. Wendy Holmes and Karen Frederick as co-directors of the tournament did a phenomenal job of pulling it all together. There are way too many club members to mention that made this all a huge success.
 - Checks in the amount of \$19,500 were presented to Mike Kitchens at SMSD by Gary and Don.
- Storage Units Swap
 - To give more space to evaluations and skills and drills equipment and items. To make the new Playback Board accessible.
- The new TV and stand have been assembled and were utilized for the tournament.
 - What is next? Gordon Young would like to use it for instruction. Stacey would like to use it at the November Social.
- Website Team
 - See Secretary/Director of Communications report.
- Legacy Program
 - Legacy team finished their assignment. The Pickleball Board unanimously approved their candidates with the exception of Jim Hyne. There is a total of 9 candidates for the first year since creating this program. Need to get bricks and get them engraved. Need to determine "signage explanation" at the site.
- Rain mitigation efforts for the Plex
 - The Parks and Rec Dept. has purchased additional flashing to alleviate most rain water from coming into the courts. Installation date to be determined.
- Kahite Seating and Shade

- This project is moving forward. Scheduled discussion and site visit to look at options on Monday, June 16th.
- 2 options have been identified and will be presented to the ACC on July 3rd, 2025 for approval. Gary is going to propose that Timeless Tellico purchase the option chosen in order to save on taxes and then the club would reimburse them. The cost is \$14,000 to \$17,000 depending on the option.
- New signs and banner.
 - Placed at Kahite Courts
- New bumpers on top of fences
 - Placed at Kahite and court 1.
- Bathrooms
 - This project will currently not be pursued due to untenable parameters as set by the Parks and Rec. Department.
- Fans for the plex
 - This project is also beginning to look untenable due to cost; 3 fans would cost approx.. \$35,000.
- Need for a Kahite pickleball representative on the Board as a nonvoting member.
 - (Suggestion: Larry Moore)
- By law changes needed for amending election procedures
 - Steve McCormick volunteered to work with Jason on developing a proposal.

Questions/Comments

Steve asked Larry if the negativity in Kahite has diminished and Larry said absolutely. He has been giving out our PB brochure which has helped answer a lot of questions. Combining level play with 2 levels (2.5 & 3.0) and (3:5 & 4.0) has helped too.

The board voted 6-0 in favor of adding Larry to the board as a non-voting board member.

Larry reported an issue with the current scheduling system not allowing a particular court to be reserved. He is working on this with Larissa.

VICE PRESIDENT – Jason Fein

Jason is recovering from recent surgery and was not able to submit a report.

SOCIAL – Stacey O’Brien

- On June 14th the Pickleball and Tennis clubs hosted a Social which was also a fundraiser for the Loudon County Sheriff's Benevolent Fund. The event featured hotdogs and a beer truck. The Sheriff and mostly Don MacLeod, cooked hotdogs for attendees. Thank you, Don! The deputies played the pickleball and tennis members and all had a great time! Both the pickleball and tennis presidents Gary and Mary Beth were arrested and put in a makeshift jail where they donned the latest correctional garb. In order to be released they had to raise the required amount of bail. The Pickleball Club raised over \$1,000 to have Gary bailed out and the Tennis Club raised over \$300 to have Maribeth bailed out. A special thanks to Mary Kay and Bill G. for creating a jail that was inescapable.
 - A special thanks to Laurie Dowe for creating the thin blue line name tags that were given to the sheriff and the deputies. Additionally, Laurie made pickleball and tennis name tags for purchase. All of the proceeds for the name tags were donated to the Loudon County Sheriff's Benevolent Fund.
 - Approximately \$4300 was raised including a \$1000 donation made by Campbell Financial.
 - The POA supplied the beer truck. Unfortunately, only 34 beers were sold, \$1.00 from each beer sold went to the benevolent fund.
 - We would like to thank the LC Sheriffs Benevolent Board, the sheriff and his deputies and of course the TV Pickleball and Tennis club members who all supported this event
- On August 13th from 6-9pm we will host an Ice Cream social. This will be an evening event to accommodate PB members who may work and cannot attend weekend events. We will be working with a local vendor to provide the ice cream.
- On November 1st from 11-2pm our Season of Giving will be combined with Volunteer Appreciation and Legacy Recognition. We need to find a local children's charity as a fundraiser. Adopt a Class has been suggested.
 - We are thinking of BBQing Hamburgers and hot dogs for this event. We will give a gift to our volunteers to thank them for their support. We will meet with a local vendor this month to see her offerings. We will also be working with the board re: the legacy project and how the social committee will be supporting that.

EVALUATIONS– Steve McCormick

- April and May: Steady number of sign-ups this season so far. Currently at a 68% move rate.
- We moved another 3 more fastrack (FT) candidates into level, which is not included in the numbers above.
- There are currently 7 FT candidates on the list.
- E-Team: Team numbers stable currently.
- I want to again thank the efforts of those that are holding eval clinics either scheduled or private. It's obvious that those are helping a great deal. Lisbeth and Tom, to name a couple.
- Additionally, I would like the board to consider renaming "Fastracks" to "Level-Placements". So far in the last two years, the term has developed a different understanding than the one we perhaps thought we were giving it.
 - There's nothing "Fast" about getting people together, with differing schedules etc.
 - These are still evals, and I feel we want new players to our club, "mentally ready" to be evaluated, not just put into a level they feel they belong.

- I am looking at ways to set up a shootout ladder league using Pickleball Den. I am going to test it with a small sample group to see how it works.

Gary announced that Ginnette has agreed to take over 2.0 Skills and Drills next year when Marianthe steps down. Either Maribeth or Gary may help her.

Matt said that Rarity Bay is developing their evaluation process and reciprocity needs to be agreed upon by TV and Rarity Bay.

IT – Mark Johnson

- Current System - Pickleball Den
 - Status:
 - System up and running
 - Signup Sheet Waitlist issue
 - Definition of issue: Members signed up for event. The members were part of the first 24 people. However, these members were pushed down to the waitlist. This happened to at least 3 members.
